

## Medallion Signature Guarantee Q&A



<b>What is a Medallion Signature Guarantee?</b>	A Medallion Signature Guarantee is a special stamp that's used when you transfer securities. It confirms that the signature authorizing the transfer is genuine and that the signer has the legal capacity and authority to sign the document.
<b>Does CommonWealth One FCU offer Medallion Signature Guarantees?</b>	Yes
<b>Which locations offer this service?</b>	Main Branch: 4875 Eisenhower Avenue Alexandria, VA 22304  Harrisonburg Regional Branch: 42 Terri Drive Harrisonburg, VA 22801
<b>Is there a fee to obtain a Medallion Signature Guarantee?</b>	There is no fee for this service, but you must be a CommonWealth One member for at least 6 months and in good standing.
<b>What is the maximum value per transaction?</b>	CommonWealth One's transaction limit is \$100,000 per transaction.
<b>What will I need if I am requesting a Medallion Signature Guarantee due to a death?</b>	You will need to bring in a copy of the Death Certificate.
<b>If I am cashing in a Bond, is there a way to see how much its worth?</b>	You can visit <a href="http://www.TreasuryDirect.gov">www.TreasuryDirect.gov</a> to see how much your bond is worth before visiting our branch.

**What form of ID is acceptable to bring in?**

You may bring in any of the following forms of unexpired ID's...

- Driver's License
- Passport
- Government Issued State ID

Please check the internet to see if any additional documents may be needed in order to complete your request.

(Example: if cashing stocks, you will need to contact the stock company to see what documents will be needed in order to cash your stocks)

Examples of possible Legal Documents required:

- Affidavit of Domicile
- Birth/ Death Certificate
- Corporate Resolution
- Inheritance Tax Waiver
- Power of Attorney
- Probate Court Certificate
- Small Estate Affidavit
- Trust Agreement
- Executor Qualification
