

Kathryn R. Coleman Financial Capability Scholarship

Guidelines

Application Deadline: Monday, March 31st, 2025

The Kathryn R. Coleman Financial Capability Scholarship will be awarded to <u>one</u> student member to help fund his/her pursuit of a higher education.

Eligibility for **\$2,500 scholarship**:

- CommonWealth One members either graduating from high school in spring/summer 2025 or continuing studies at a college, university, or other institution of higher learning in the 2025-2026 academic year.
- 1. **Student applicants must be primary members of CommonWealth One** Applicants must have an account in his or her own name at the credit union. Joint owners are **not** considered primary members.
- 2. Employees, directors, and committee members of CommonWealth One (and their immediate family members) are <u>NOT</u> eligible for the scholarship.
- 3. Applicants must submit:
 - a. Completed scholarship application
 - b. Official **sealed** school transcript(s)*
 - c. Completed activities information and an essay of 250-500 words, typed and double-spaced *(Please <u>DO NOT</u> put your name on your essay)*
 - d. A recent full color headshot and/or acceptance video interview will be requested if selected as winner (Photographs and videos will be used in CommonWealth One press releases, social post and advertising).
- 4. The items above must be sent to CommonWealth One Headquarters and received by **Sunday**, **March 31**, **2025**. Incomplete or late entries will not be considered. **Submit entries to:**

5. Applicants must be planning to attend an accredited college, university, or other institution of higher learning during the 2025-2026 academic year.

6. **The award of \$2,500...** will be paid to the appropriate office at the educational institution of choice (must submit proof of registration). Money must be applied to the 2025-2026 academic year.

- 7. CommonWealth One judges' decisions are final. CommonWealth One also reserves the right to cancel the competition in the event that too few qualified applications are received.
- 8. Winner will be notified no later than by the beginning of May 2025. Only the winning applicant will be notified.

* Freshman applicants – please submit both a high school transcript and college transcript.

- 1. Please type or print your application clearly; essays should be typed and double-spaced.
- 2. Applicant must be a **primary member** of CommonWealth One.
- 3. Please **DO NOT** write your name, account number, or social security number on your essay or activities pages.
- 4. Application, essay, and sealed official transcripts must be received by **Monday**, **March 31**, **2025**. Late entries will not be considered. **Submit completed package to:**
